Salvation Army Kick Starts Their “Angel Tree” Program at a CIA Developer Managed Property

MELBOURNE, Fla., November 21, 2008 – With Christmas just around the corner, the Salvation Army has begun their yearly “Angel Tree” toy drive for children. The toys donated to the program will go to children who may not be fortunate enough to have gifts under the tree come Christmas morning. In addition to children, the Salvation Army also provides gifts to Senior Citizens and a sit down dinner for nearly 700 individuals on Thanksgiving Day and 500 individuals on Christmas Day.

“It has really been a joy assisting the Salvation Army with their efforts” said Gary Cunningham II, Vice President of CIA Developers. “The holiday season really is about giving and the Salvation Army provides such a wonderful service to the community.”

The Salvation Army selected 11,000 sq. ft. of warehouse space in Fortune Cookie Park off of Johns Rodes Blvd. This central location will serve as the collection, storage, and distribution point for the entire operation. This year they estimate they will be helping 1,279 Senior Citizens, 1,052 children and 425 families with Christmas assistance.

“The Angel Tree program is a large undertaking that relies heavily on the support of the community” said Major Tim Williford with the Salvation Army. “The program has a rich history of success over past 20 years and we are looking forward to another great year.”

The process of the program takes approximately two months. The Salvation Army began taking applications in October. Next the Angel Trees are sent out to different individuals and organizations that purchase the gifts on the wish list. As the toys begin to return in December, they are matched with the children they were purchased for. The toys are then packaged together by family and sent out the week before Christmas.
